- Providing palliative care for patients with life-limiting illnesses
- Utilizing the principles of pain and symptom management for patients with advanced disease
- Addressing ethical issues that occur at the end-of-life
- Providing culturally sensitive care at the end-of-life and communication techniques that improve end-of-life care
